



Fishing regulations for ponds from 1.1.2025

Fishing season:

1 March (only if the water surface is largely ice-free) until 30 November

Fishing time:

5:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., from May 1 to September 30 inclusive from 5:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Licenses for 24-hour fishing are available for the Karlovy Vary Pond in June, July and August.

Fishing gear and equipment:

The licence is valid for two poles (youth holiday card and special licence: one pole) with up to two single hooks each. The use of a small bait spiral on the main line is permitted. Multiple hooks are generally prohibited and may not be used on spoons, twisters, etc. or on systems with dead baitfish. Each fisherman must carry a pair of release pliers, a tape measure and a suitable writing instrument (no pencil, etc.).

With the exception of silent bite alarms, the use of external technical aids of any kind (bait boats, feed catapults, drones, fish finders, underwater cameras, etc.) is prohibited. In the period from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., only silent bite alarms are permitted.

Daily and annual catch:

4 fish per day, two of which are carp.

After reaching the day's catch, fishing must be stopped. An annual licence entitles the holder to catch a maximum of 100 fish, 50 of which are carp. Once this catch has been reached, the licence loses its validity regardless of the duration of fishing in the respective area.

Every fish that is taken or kept in the landing net must be entered in the licence certificate or in the catch book immediately after it has been caught and before fishing is resumed. The fish caught must be kept with him at the fishing spot and shown to the supervisory bodies on request.

Minimum dimensions and closed seasons:

Perch	-	1 February to 31 May
Pike	50 cm	1 February to 31 May
Zander	40 cm	1 February to 31 May
Tench	25 cm	1 June to 31 July
Carp	35 cm	No closed season
Amur	60 cm	No closed season
Tolstolob	60 cm	No closed season
Common rudd	15 cm	16 April to 30 June
Rainbow trout	30 cm	No closed season

For all other fish, the legal closed seasons and minimum sizes apply. Undersized fish or fish caught in the closed season must be released with the greatest care.

Permitted baits:

All legally permitted baits may be used.

Fishing by children:

- Children of annual pass holders: See entry in the annual ticket.
- Free fishing by children: One child under the age of 12 per licence holder may fish free of charge with a light bait fishing rod with a small float, clamping lead and single hook. The catch of the child fishing with the fish is added to the daily catch of the licensee. The child must be in close proximity to the licensee, who is also responsible for the child's compliance with the regulations
- Fishing by children with a licence but without their own annual fishing licence (tax card): Children up to the age of 15 may fish without restriction against payment of the licence fee, provided they are accompanied by an adult licence holder.

Multi-day tickets:

Multi-day tickets are valid for one calendar year from the day of issue and must contain the non-erasable entry of the Fisherman's Day before the start of fishing.

Please pay particular attention to the following prohibitions:

- Start fishing without a valid license (no pre-sale at the pond!)
- Any form of disclosure of licenses to other persons
- The exchange of fish in the landing net
- Shedding and gutting fish at the pond (pond)
- Feeding (even with food baskets) is prohibited by the sanitary police and is punishable by law

Cleanliness at the fishing spot, animal welfare and hunting justice

The fishing spots must be kept clean. Dirty fishing spots must be cleaned or must not be used.

Particular attention must be paid to waterfowl in the bird sanctuary. To prevent injuries to dogs and swans, baited hooks must not be accessible unattended. When unhooking out of the water, the use of an unhooking mat is recommended.

Behaviour that is not in accordance with animal welfare, cruelty to animals as well as the violation of legal regulations or the above provisions will result in the immediate withdrawal of the licence, in addition to other administrative or criminal consequences. License fees already paid have been forfeited. The instructions of the supervisory bodies must be followed. According to the Salzburg State Fisheries Act, supervisory bodies are also entitled to inspect luggage and vehicles.
